



Project Title:

International Day of Peace Random Acts of Kindness

Project Description:

Phase I: Prior to Sept 21 (the United Nations International Day of Peace), all Rotarians in District 5180, their family members, friends, and acquaintances, will be encouraged to perform at least ONE random act of kindness on Sept 21, and report their experience on the Rotary Club of North Sacramento Peacebuilders Club Facebook page. A flyer has been distributed to every club president and every Assistant Governor. The flyer has also been disseminated via Facebook to Rotarians and non-Rotarians, together with a request to share with all their Facebook friends.

Phase II: We will print business cards with the Rotary logo on one side and instructions on the other side. The card will be given to the recipient of a random act of kindness. The instructions will encourage the recipient to “pay it forward” and perform a random act of kindness for a person who is of another political ideology, race, religion, ethnicity, gender identity, or socio-economic class than the recipient. The recipient will also be encouraged to enter a summary of the random act they received and the random act they performed on the Peacebuilders Club Facebook page.

Each time a random act of kindness is performed, the card is to be given to the new recipient, so the card follows the random acts of kindness.

The cards will be distributed to all Rotarians in District 5180 and additional cards will be available for non-Rotarians to circulate. Interact or Rotaract students could also be involved in performing acts of kindness as well as disseminating the cards.
